



Biological Survey Weekend (16 to 19 March 2012) and Land For Wildlife Biodiversity Field Day (Mon 19 March) – at Balijup Farm near Lake Nunijup, Tenterden

Weekend Biological Camp from 4pm Friday 16th March to 9am Monday 19th March 2012.

Gondwana/Land for Wildlife Biodiversity Field Day 9am to 12.30pm Monday 19th March 2012.

You are invited to join in a weekend biological survey camp on Balijup farm, near Tenterden in March. The farm has over 700 hectares of forests and wetlands and is remarkably diverse. During the weekend, a number of scientists and amateur natural historians will carry out surveys of the flora, fauna and wetlands to expand our knowledge of this unique land for wildlife property. It will provide a great opportunity to learn and help out on this ecological project, forming part of the Gondwana Link.

Each participant to self cater for food and bring own camping gear. A hot shower and toilet facilities will be available.

How to get to the Camp and Field Day site:

Travel approx 30km north from Mt Barker on Albany Highway;

Turn left 50 metres before the Tenterden store onto Nunijup Road;

Travel approximately 8.5km in a south-westerly direction to green property number 861 at the “Balijup” driveway entrance and turn left.

Event signposting will be in place. If you come to Balijup Road or meet Martagallup Road you have gone too far.

Weekend Cost per person \$25.
